



Build Cross Platform Apps With Photino


- Build native, cross-platform desktop apps that are lighter than light.


Windows

Not a whole lot of Windows news at BUILD...

- Windows Store
- WSL (preview) is now available in the Microsoft Store
- Windows 365
- Windows Subsystem for Android
- Windows-on-Arm (WoA)
- Windows App SDK 1.1 (preview) available
- Widgets (including 3rd party widgets)

Windows Subsystem for Android

- Enables Android Apps to run on Windows
- Delivered to Windows through the Amazon Appstore
 - The Amazon Appstore can be installed through the Windows Store
 - This automatically installs the Android Subsystem
- This is currently in public preview (US only)




Microsoft Dev Box (Project "Fidalgo")

- High-performance developer workstations on Azure based on Windows 365 Cloud PCs that are instantly ready to use
 - Currently in preview
- Motivations:
 - Tackling the complexity of dev environment setup
 - Managing incompatibility and conflicts between environments
 - "Day 1" onboarding experience for new developers
 - Security of remote devices
 - Varying industry standards
 - Enabling and leveraging remote working in development
 - 82% of people working remotely assume this will continue
 - 52% of developers say they would leave an on-site job for remote work

Project "Volterra"

- ARM dev kit built in the Snapdragon compute platform
- Windows-on-Arm (WoA) development environment
- ARM-based versions of dev tools
- Includes NPUs (Neural Processing Units) for AI scenarios



Microsoft Power Platform

- Low-Code platform
- Low-Code development is becoming more and more important
 - Some estimates predict 70% of future development needs may be covered by low-code technologies
- Power Platform: 5 Products
 - Power BI
 - Power Apps
 - Power Pages (new!)
 - Power Automate
 - Power Virtual Agents





Azure

Azure App Service

- Fundamental service used to host web apps on Azure
- Windows and Linux
- Recent enhancements:
 - Google Remote Procedure Call (gRPC)
 - Bulk migration capabilities
 - Landing Zone Accelerator




Azure Container Apps

- Serverless container solution
- Auto-scale (including "scale-to-zero")
- Easier to use and deploy, compared to a typical Kubernetes setup
- However: Seamlessly upgrades to Kubernetes as needed



Azure Kubernetes Service

- Still a great way to set up containerdriven environments
- Provides great control over containerized systems
- Enabled DevOps scenarios



SQL Azure

- New version of SQL Server on Azure
- Microsoft Intelligent Data Platform

 Cool feature alert: Ledger support (Blockchain)



Azure Cosmos DB Preview

- Increased serverless capacity to 1TB
- New 30-day free trial!





Al & Machine Learning

Azure Al

- Al is becoming more and more important in many scenarios
 - It is more difficult to think of scenarios that *can't* benefit from AI, than it is to think of scenarios that can
- Microsoft is launching more and more turn-key AI services
- Microsoft is also enabling fundamental AI & Machine Learning development in a variety of ways

Models as a Platform

Microsoft Al

- Turing Rich language understanding
- Z-Code 100 languages translation
- Florence Breakthrough visual recognition

OpenAl

- GPT Human-like language generation
- DALL-E Realistic image generation
- Codex Advanced code generation

Azure OpenAl Services


- New reasoning and comprehension capabilities for text-based scenarios
- Examples: Writing assistance, code generation, making sense of unstructured data
- Now available as a limited access preview

Cognitive Service for Language

- Natural Language Processing (NLP)
- Examples:
 - Named entity recognition (NER)
 - Key phrase extraction
 - Summaries, language detection
 - Sentiment analysis
 - ...


Azure Form Recognizer

- Another great example for a pre-trained model that has recently been improved
- Very useful service for business application scenarios



Responsible Al Dashboard

- Dashboard for Data Scientists
- Aims to more easily implement responsible Al
- Helps analyze why AI comes to certain conclusions
 - Data exploration
 - Fairness
 - Model interpretability
 - Error analysis
 - Counterfactual inference analysis
 - Causal inference analysis
 - ...



- Minor Releases if needed






.NET 6 on Azure



.NET 5 – End of Support

- .NET 5 Extended Support ended May 8th, 2022
- Apps will continue to run, but will not be patched
- Transition to .NET 6 if possible
 - Which should be exceptionally easy to do
 - This is not an emergency, but a good idea when convenient

GA/Current vs. LTS



- Current versions (GA) are supported 15 months
 - (3 months after the next version's release date)
- LTS versions are supported for 3 years
- It should be easy to update from GA to LTS versions

Visual Studio 2022

- Resurgence of the "Full VS IDE"
- Snappier due to optimizations, including native 64-bit
- 17.3 Preview 2 includes
 Windows-on-Arm support
 - Supporting the most common Arm project types

- Al-aided development
- Currently available as a technical preview



GitHub


- GitHub is "the place to be" for developers



- .NET MAUI 1.0 Released!
 - Available with Visual Studio 17.3 Preview 1

- Cross-platform, native UI with XAML and C#
- Access native capabilities from a single API
- Deploy to mobile devices and desktops



Blazor

- Blazor has now been around for 4 years!
- Blazor "traditionally" supports two hosting models:
 - Blazor Server
 - Blazor WebAssembly
- With MAUI, we can now build native apps using Blazor hybrid components
 - This enables us to reuse Blazor skills and components
 - Blazor components execute natively when hosted inside of MAUI
 - Note: This also works with WPF and WinForms



 - Code in auto-properties




